APPLICATION INFORMATION	
Nomination Process	Exchange student should be first nominated by their home institution providing with basic information: name, field of study, expected period of stay and –very important- an e-mail address so we can contact students directly.
Application Process	Online: Once the student has been officially nominated by their home university International Office, they will receive an e-mail with a password and instructions to complete the application on-line. No paper applications must be submitted.
Application Deadlines	Semester 1 and full year: 30th June Semester 2: 15th January
Definitive Registration of Courses	Online. Enrolment is made through a self enrolment on-line system by the student in the month of July. Students will receive an e-mail with a password and user name to access the self-enrolment on-line and information about available courses. Semester 1 and full year: July Semester 2: January



LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS		
Spanish / English	Although there is a range of courses taught in English, most of them are delivered in Spanish. Therefore, all incoming students should have sufficient language skills to attend lectures and sit examinations. We do not require evidence of their level of Spanish; however, we strongly recommend students to have at least a B1 of Spanish.
