APPLICATION INFORMATION	
Nomination Process	Exchange student should be first nominated by their home institution providing with basic information: name, field of study, expected period of stay and –very important- an e-mail address so we can contact students directly.
Application Process	Online: Once the student has been officially nominated by their home university International Office, they will receive an e-mail with a password and instructions to complete the application on-line. No paper applications must be submitted.
Application Deadlines	Semester 1 and full year: 30th June Semester 2: 30th November
Definitive Registration of Courses	Online. Enrolment is made through a self enrolment on-line system by the student in the month of July. Students will receive an e-mail with a password and user name to access the self-enrolment on-line and information about available courses. Semester 1 and full year: July Semester 2: January



## LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Spanish / English	<p>Although there is a range of courses taught in English, most of them are delivered in Spanish. Therefore, all incoming students should have sufficient language skills to attend lectures and sit examinations.</p> <p>We do not require evidence of their level of Spanish; however, we strongly recommend students to have at least a B1 of Spanish.</p>
